

Addendum to 2007 Grantham University Catalog – Awarding of Associate Degrees

This addendum supersedes the awarding of associate degrees as indicated in *Section V - Curricula* of the 2007 Grantham University Catalog. Each of the degree program matrices in this section indicate that an associate degree is awarded after completion of semesters one through four of the bachelor degree program. Accordingly, it was Grantham's practice to award associate degrees to students who completed semesters one through four of a bachelor degree program, whether or not the student actually enrolled in an associate degree program.

Effective December 3, 2007, Grantham University no longer awards associate degrees to students who enroll in a bachelor degree program and complete semesters one through four of that program. Students will be awarded a degree only for the program in which they officially enroll. An associate degree will be awarded only upon fulfillment of all requirements of the associate degree program in which the student is officially enrolled; a bachelor degree will be awarded only upon fulfillment of all requirements of the bachelor degree program in which the student is officially enrolled; and a masters degree will be awarded only upon fulfillment of all requirements of the masters degree program in which the student is officially enrolled.

Only students who enroll in the University on or after December 3, 2007 will be governed by this policy change. Any students who enrolled in the University prior to December 3, 2007 will be awarded the associate degree upon fulfillment of all requirements as outlined in the catalog under which they enrolled. However, students who enrolled prior to December 3, 2007, but are inactive for 12 months or more, will be governed by this policy change upon their return to the University.
